## A MATTER OF LIGHT

## Nine photographers in the Vatican Museums

On the occasion of "Milan Photo Week", the Palazzo Reale opens its doors for a preview of an unprecedented "reportage", which narrates in images one of the most well-known and significant museums in the world. Nine masters of photography - Italian and foreign - take an original approach to a place that is unique and precious in terms of art, history and architecture: the Vatican Museums.

The exhibition project, presented for the first time in Palazzo Reale, offers a dialectical comparison of visions. With the exhibition "A Matter of light", the museum opens up to a dialectical exchange through the interpretative skill of nine artists, with different stylistic codes, called by the Vatican Museums to produce autonomously a visual reflection on their artistic and architectural heritage.

Thanks to the diverse and unusual points of view and approaches, the visitor travels through the museum with an approach in which the space, people, works and architecture become the object of an unusual, unsettling, stimulating narrative.
