THE TICKET INCLUDES:

-  Reserved "skip the line" entrance and open visit to the Vatican Museums with special audioguide
-  Multilingual audioguide service (Italian, English, Spanish, German, French, Russian)
-  Transfer on foot through the Vatican Gardens with audioguide
-  Round trip on electric train from the Vatican City railway station to the Castel Gandolfo station
-  Transfer by shuttle bus to the Pontifical Villas of Castel Gandolfo
-  Tour by ecological vehicle of the Barberini Garden (Pontifical Villas of Castel Gandolfo) with special audioguide
-  Transfer by shuttle bus to the railway station of Castel Gandolfo
-  Return journey by electric train from the Castel Gandolfo railway station to the Roma San Pietro station

USEFUL TO KNOW...

-  The guided tour is not suitable for wheelchair users and is not recommended for visitors with limited mobility
-  Access is granted only to visitors who are appropriately dressed (sleeveless and/or low cut garments, shorts and mini-skirts are not permitted)
-  The cloakroom service is not available for this type of visit
-  Packages and suitcases are not permitted
-  Only small bags and rucksacks are permitted
-  Full-size (non-folding) or large umbrellas are not permitted
-  It is possible to bring plastic bottles only
-  Photography is permitted without the use of flash
-  The use of photographic stands and tripods is not permitted
-  Smoking is not permitted on transport and in the tour areas
-  Animals are not permitted
-  Food may not be consumed during the visit
-  The use of telescopic "selfie sticks" is not permitted
-  Visitors are advised to wear comfortable footwear
-  Sticks are not permitted, other than walking sticks
-  Visitors may be subject to security checks
-  The guided tour is confirmed also in adverse weather conditions
