Thanks to recent promotional agreements, the Vatican Museums are able to offer reductions and special entry fees, as well as special discounts on the purchase of goods and non-museum services

Keep your ticket. An invitation for you to a truly special Palace!

Take advantage of a promotion to visit the **Apostolic Palace of Castel Gandolfo**. A **special entry fee of 7 Euros** is reserved to all those who can present at the entrance in Piazza della Libertà a ticket or booking for a visit to the Vatican Museums. If on the other hand you are already at Castel Gandolfo and have participated in a guided tour of the Barberini Garden of the Pontifical Villas, keep your ticket and conclude your itinerary at the **Apostolic Palace**, at the **reduced fee of 7 Euros!**

A special promotional tariff of **16 Euros** per person is reserved to those who, having already booked a visit to the Apostolic Palace, decide upon arrival to participate, on the same day, in a **tour of the Pontifical Villas of Castel Gandolfo** (Villa Barberini) **on board an eco-vehicle**. The tour may be purchased directly *in loco*, according to availability.

If you have already booked online a *visit to the Apostolic Palace*, or if you have bought a ticket *in loco*, you can **"stroll" in the Villa Barberini Gardens** on the same day, taking advantage of the special **promotional price of 8 Euros** per person. Purchase is possible directly at the ticket office, subject to availability.

Do you donate blood at the Tor Vergata Policlinico? The Vatican Museums offer you special access, skipping the line, for just 4 euros!

A noble and selfless gesture such as that of giving blood is rewarded by the *Pope's Museums* with a significant discount on the ticket price. Donors who present themselves at the Blood Transfusion Centres of the Tor Vergata Policlinico (Rome) will be given a personal voucher for **"special" entry, skipping the line**, at the price of **4 euros**, to be used **by 31 December 2019**.
